Call for 2017 IAWRT Biennial hosting proposals

Dear IAWRT Member,

It's Biennial year! IAWRT's call for hosting proposals is now open!

If you would like to host this flagship conference in your country in late October/early November 2017, submit a detailed proposal on how you would organize this event, including:

- *A description of the event (when, where, conference theme, etc.)*
- *A detailed budget, plus a financial plan (you should have a plan for fundraising in the country)*

The 3-4 days conference will be a 3 - part event:

1. A one day conference with a theme around **Gender and Media** (this is also an upcoming theme for 2018 UN CSW)
2. One, or one and a half day for organizational development including biennial members meeting, strategic workshop outgoing from the evaluation report and a workshop about Gender Mainstreaming project implementation.
3. One day for screenings including the newly launched IAWRT documentary Velvet Revolution (on the theme Women Making News) and showcasing contributions/winners of the IAWRT/FOKUS Awards of Excellence.

Note that the organization of part 2 and 3 is more or less the responsibility of the International Board and its relevant Committées. However, the costs for venues, accommodation and screening facilities for all conference days must be included in your

proposed budget. Plan for participation of between 50 and 60 attendants. We hope to be able to fund, or partly fund participation of more members than usually.

The International Board will set up a Biennial Committee that will work closely with the host country to help organize the event. Please send your proposals before April 15th 2017 to secretariat@iawrt.org
